OTIE draws upon the knowledge and experience of 300 employees to deliver solutions that provide sustainable benefits. OTIE integrates


construction managers and technicians, engineers, and scientists for dedicated, cooperative, and businesslike delivery of services to cultivate community consensus and enhance our customers' missions.
